Landowner Relations Director Job Description

The Landowner Relations Director represents the interests of the GHTA and its member clubs to landowners and other outside stakeholders where it is more appropriate that this be handled by the Association than by member clubs individually. Institutional landowners such as upper tier local government, lower tier local governments with more than one GHTA member club in their municipal area, Provincial government agencies including the Ministry of Natural Resources, Ontario Parks and Conservation Authorities may prefer a single individual as a contact person and the Association may designate the Landowner Relations Director to this responsibility. If called on by government agencies as part of their policy planning, the Landowner Relations Director accepts the responsibility of speaking for hikers and walkers at committees and public consultation hearings. He responds to requests from member clubs for assistance in dealing with landowners on such issues as liability and insurance, risk management and environmental stewardship.
